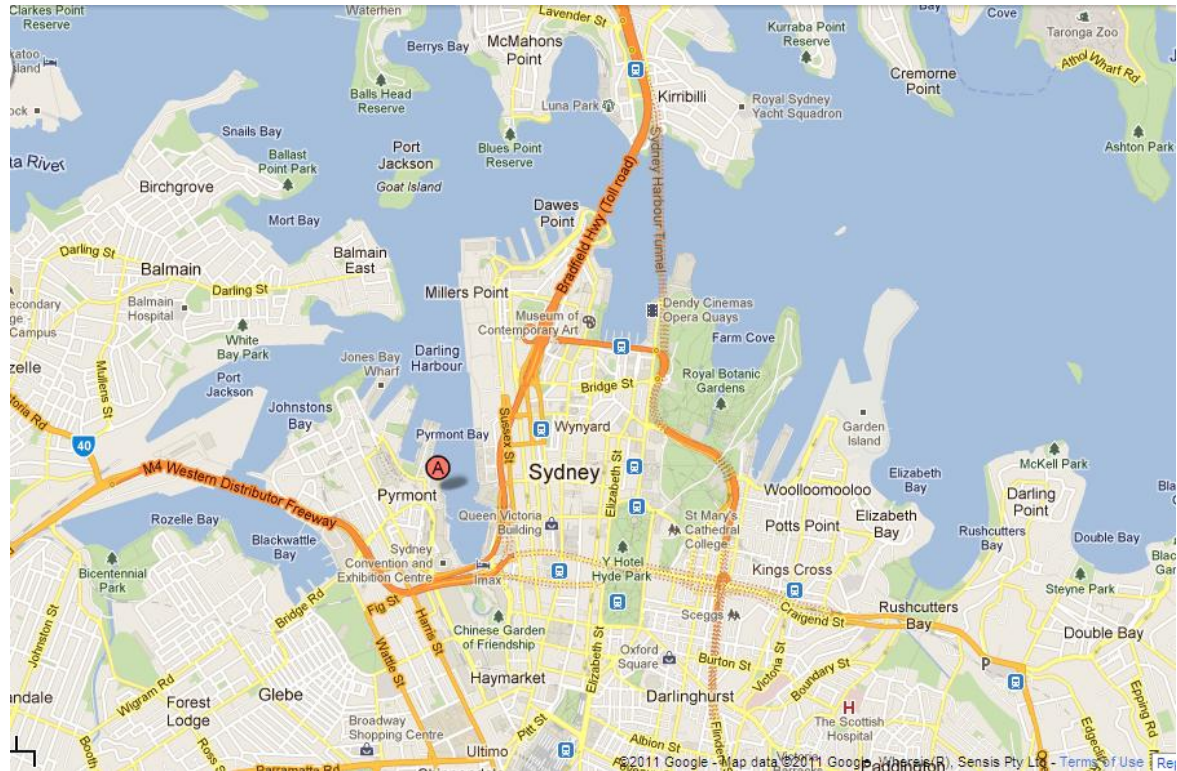




DUYFKEN 1606 REPLICA FOUNDATION

Duyfken is currently at the **Australian National Maritime Museum** in Darling Harbour, **Sydney**.



The museum is open each day (except Christmas Day) from 9.30am to 5.00pm (6.00pm in January) and is within easy reach from the centre of Sydney via the Pyrmont Bridge. Train, bus, rail, monorail and light rail options are also within easy walking distance. Please note that you need to be 90cm tall to board *Duyfken*. A full tour of the vessel will entail confined spaces and climbing ladders, so please be prepared. Flat, enclosed shoes are strongly recommended for your safety and high heels are not to be worn on board.
